| <p>1 One or two minor dents; otherwise substantially in good condition; all well marked</p> <p>2 Small 'salt' spot at side of the sugar basin near handle; otherwise in good condition; all well marked</p> <p>3 Small repair at base of one oval; handles very slightly pushed in at lower joints; otherwise substantially in good condition; well marked below the rim</p> <p>4 A few very minor dents; otherwise in good condition; both well marked on the side</p> <p>5 A few very minor dents at the base edges; one edge has a small circular patch (6 mm); otherwise in substantially good condition; filled construction (no holes); well marked on the base edges and nozzle flanges</p> <p>6 Engraved with a lion passant crest over possible erasure; repair to wooden handle; a few minor dents mostly around the lower body; otherwise in substantially good condition; well marked under the base and with lion passant inside the cover</p> <p>7 Engraved with a crest on the cover; minor dents at the base rim; possible repair at the joint of the handle at the rim; otherwise substantially in good condition; has been converted from a jug; marked on the side and under the cover; side marks a bit worn</p> <p>8 Engraved with crests, cartouches enclosing lions passant and the motto 'FAITHFUL AND BRAVE'; also engraved under the bellies and inside the covers with security numerals; one cover is a tight fit (mismatched from a set of four); substantially in good condition; well marked under the bellies, on the finial handles and on the cover flanges</p> <p>9 One or two very small dents are not significant; some wear to gilding; otherwise substantially in good condition; all well marked - on the collar, cover, strap and spigot</p> <p>10 One or two minor dents; otherwise in substantially in good condition; all well marked under the bases, inside the covers and on the handles</p> <p>11 Engraved with initial M; in good condition; all well marked</p> <p>12 Engraved with initial M; in good condition; all well marked</p> <p>13 A few minor superficial scuffs are not significant; otherwise in good condition; well marked under the base (1933-44) and on the side with British import marks for London, 1936</p> | <p>14 In good condition; all well marked under the bases</p> <p>15 In good condition; well marked on the base rims only with 12 LÖTH. and 3851 or 3872</p> <p>16 In good condition; well marked below the rims</p> <p>17 In good condition; well marked under the base</p> <p>18 Engraved with a chrysanthemum monogram RJ on one side of the cover; substantially in good condition; well marked under the base, including numerals 691(7?)8 / 2260 and T</p> <p>19 Engraved with a chrysanthemum monogram RJ on one side of the sauce boat and a foliate scroll version on the stand; one or two tiny dents to the belly of the sauce boat are not significant; otherwise substantially in good condition; well marked under the bases, including numerals 12560 / 1997 and T on the sauce boat and 5715 / 2416 and T on the stand</p> <p>20 Engraved with an initial S; one applied silver bird is missing from kettle; otherwise in substantially good condition; original maker's marks appear to have been removed; all fully marked with import marks</p> <p>21 Engraved with initial K(?); one or two very minor dents; a few salt spots; otherwise substantially in good condition; well marked under the base</p> <p>22 Engraved with initials; in well used and abused condition - with some general wear, bent shanks and burred edges to tea spoon bowls; knife blades are old steel (not stainless) and are watermarked; all well marked</p> <p>23 Bobeche at top of one candlestick base has been replaced (border not quite matching); otherwise substantially in good condition; well marked on the base edges and on the branch section flanges, including numerals 78 (1878?)</p> <p>24 Engraved with a monogram; some minor crazing to silvering on the plate; otherwise substantially in good condition; well marked on the lower edge including numerals 152</p> <p>25 Loss to nine red 'jewels'; may be missing covers; otherwise in good condition</p> <p>26 Minor crack to one saucer; otherwise in good condition; one saucer is 1929</p> <p>Cups: St. Paul's (signed); Tower of London (not signed); Westminster Bridge (signed); Royal Exchange (not signed); St. James Palace (signed); Tower Bridge (signed)</p> <p>Saucers: Trafalgar Square (signed); Rotten Row</p> | <p>(signed); The Serpentine (not signed); St. Paul's fr. Embankment (signed); Buckingham Palace (1929; signed); Royal Exchange (crack; not signed)</p> <p>27 Small restoration to a chip on one handle; tiny chip at one lower corner of base; otherwise substantially in good condition; the cover is a wooden replacement</p> <p>28 Gilding wear; one tureen has a repaired cover and has a shallow chip at the base; chips to the other finial, a circular dish and a plate</p> <p>29 A few very minor chips to applied florets at the rim are barely significant; otherwise substantially in good condition</p> <p>30 Two minor cracks at the base; head broken through at the neck and repaired; two small glaze flaws at the coat tail hem; glaze slightly speckled on the forehead and nose; otherwise substantially in good condition</p> <p>31 Shallow chip at spout (approx 1.5 cm); otherwise in good condition</p> <p>32 Two minor chips at the corners of the rim; some minor speckling of the glaze at two corners of the rim; otherwise substantially in good condition</p> <p>33 Tureen broken in several pieces and repaired; glaze on the cover is speckled</p> <p>34 In good condition</p> <p>35 Infant's head stopper has been replaced with gilt metal; minor chips to applied flowers and one strap at neck; a little wear to monkey's head</p> <p>36 Some restoration to the pipe, boy's left arm/shoulder and hat and to the stopper; tiny chip under the base edge</p> <p>37 Very minor losses to applied flowers; tiny chip under the base edge; otherwise substantially in good condition</p> <p>38 Restoration to both figures; stopper replaced</p> <p>39 Stopper mount replaced; otherwise substantially in good condition</p> <p>40 Minor wear to enamels and gilding; otherwise In good condition</p> <p>41 Restoration to stick, both arms and upper body</p> <p>42 In good condition</p> <p>43 In good condition</p> <p>44 In good condition</p> <p>45 Loss only to dolphin tail at front; very small chip at mermaid's tail; minor glaze flaws to lower body; otherwise substantially in good condition; impressed numerals 31 under the base are the only marks visible</p> <p>46 Originally an ewer, now adapted as a table</p> |
