Condition Reports

- 1 In good condition; apparently not marked
- 2 Engraved with initials K.B.G. on the upper left hand corner of the back; a few very minor scratches; well marked on the interior edges, both sides
- 3 The enameled case engraved with initials F.J.; the nielloed one with a presentation inscription on the interior; some wear and other minor signs of use; otherwise substantially in good condition; both well marked
- 4 In good condition
- 5 One engraved with a monogram; a few minor dents and some wear; otherwise substantially in good condition; all well marked
- 6 The cosmetic box engraved with a monogram; substantially in good condition, all well marked
- 7 Engraved with a monogram; a few very minor dents; otherwise substantially in good condition; well marked under the bases B. PETERSEN & CO. / STERLING SILVER
- 8 Four engraved with initials or monograms; a few minor dents; one or two minor chips; otherwise substantially in good condition; all well marked
- 9 As found
- 10 One inner stopper only; a few minor dents to silver caps; one or two very tiny chips to the glass edges; otherwise substantially in good condition; apparently not marked
- 11 One inner stopper only; in good condition
- 12 Chip to base of stopper on smaller overlaid bottle is not significant; otherwise substantially in good condition; all well marked - the English cut glass bottle Birmingham, 1891, the overlaid amber bottle is Gorham
- 13 Four engraved with initials or monograms; a few minor dents; one or two minor chips; otherwise substantially in good condition; all well marked
- 14 One or two minor chips and a crack to glass; minor dents to metal or silver mounts; otherwise in substantially good condition
- 15 A few minor dents and small chips; bruise at shoulder of red overlaid and cut glass bottle; otherwise substantially in good condition

- 18 In substantially good condition; marked 935S and MADE IN GERMANY respectively
- 19 Case is showing signs of wear, with hinged mount detached; otherwise substantially in good condition

- 21 A few minor dents; otherwise in substantially good condition; well marked except for those on the later table, which are not distinct
- 22 In substantially good condition; well marked under the bases
- 23 In substantially good condition; well marked in the sides
- 24 Engraved with an inscription on one cartouche; a few minor dents; otherwise substantially in good condition; well marked on the side below the rim
- 25 Engraved with initial J on the top of the cover; screw-on cover; in substantially good condition; well marked on the base and side of cover
- 26 One or two minor dents; otherwise substantially in good condition; both well marked on the sides and cover flanges
- 27 Foot is slightly bent; otherwise substantially in good condition; well marked on the side
- 28 Seam at the shoulder is imperfect; otherwise substantially in good condition; well marked on the side and cover collar
- 29 In good condition; well marked under the base, inside cover, etc.
- 30 A few minor dents; bases of coffee pot and cream jug are a little bent; otherwise substantially in good condition; all well marked (coffee pot is the later date)
- 31 Cartouche has been patched; handle repaired; otherwise in substantially good condition; well marked under the belly
- 32 Repair at lower join of one handle; otherwise substantially in good condition; marks under the spouts are worn - one legible as 1812, the other after 1820
- 33 Repairs at the rim and feet; marks under the belly are very worn
- 34 Engraved with crown issuing goat's head crest; substantially in good condition; well marked under the base and on the cover flange
- 35 One or two very minor dents; otherwise substantially in good condition; well marked under the bases
- 36 A few very minor chips to glass; some salt spots and areas of corrosion under the bottles; all marked (some worn/incomplete) - spoon later
- 37 Engraved with a fir tree crest; a couple of repairs to the shell bowl; otherwise substantially in good condition; marks are anomalous - Hibernia, crowned harp and top of date letter T appear to be good for 1739, but Haines is recorded as working 30 years or more later - the C.H maker's mark appears to have been let in - likely a re-worked duty-dodger
- 38 Engraved with a crest; minor repair to the bowl; otherwise substantially in good condition; barely legible (worn) marks on the back of the shank CT in rectangle twice, flanking STERLING
- 39 A little worn; otherwise substantially in good condition; only leopard's head crowned and maker's mark are legible on the back of the shank (worn)
- 40 Engraved with initials E=L B and dated 1813; minor dents to bowls; otherwise substantially in good condition; both well marked with JQ in rectangle on the back of the handle
- 41 In good condition; well marked on the back of the terminal
- 42 Ladle engraved with camel's head crest; tip of scoop a little rough-edged and ivory handle cracked; otherwise substantially in good condition; both well marked
